

Erie County Technical School 2021-2022: School/Work Daily Symptom Screening Tool

**All staff and students are responsible for monitoring symptoms daily
prior to attending school/work
and
staying home if they are sick.**

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. This list does not include all possible symptoms (CDC,2021).

- Fever (100 degrees or higher) or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

If you/your student has any of the following symptoms(fever, sore throat, cough, diarrhea, vomiting, or severe headache) they might have an illness they can spread to others (CDC,2021)

Stay Home, Call Your Doctor, and/or GET TESTED.

Please notify the Nurse/Assistant Pandemic Coordinator immediately if you/the student:

- Schedule a COVID-19 test or are waiting for results
- You have a POSITIVE COVID-19 test (or any member in your household)
- You have been identified as a close contact to someone with COVID-19

The Erie County Technical School will coordinate with the you, your sending school, and the Erie County Department of Health to ensure a safe return to school/work.
